TOUR OF BRITAIN CYCLE EVENT
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT ORDER

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the staging of the Tour of Britain Cycle Events from 15 September 2010, it intends to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict to vehicular traffic passage along the route of the Tour and access to that route from side roads and only whilst the Tour is in the vicinity of those roads.

The provisions of the Order will not prevent access being maintained for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which this Order relates, or to any other premises accessible from, and only from, such a road.

The Order will come into effect on 15 September 2010 and will remain in force for 2 days. The roads will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access):

- a) To facilitate a Music Concert and Entertainment from 1900hrs to 2300 hrs on 15 September 2010 at U20504 Kings Staithe Square and U20546 South Quay
- b) To facilitate the set up and start of the Tour from 2300hrs on 15 September to 1600hrs on 16 September at U20408 Tuesday Market Place East and U20407 Tuesday Market Place South and
- c) From 0900hrs to 1600hrs on 16 September at C544 Tuesday Market Place in the TOWN OF KING'S LYNN and
- d) To facilitate the Tour route from C544 Tuesday Market Place eastwards towards the A149 Sandringham, Hunstanton, B1105 Wells-next-the-Sea, A148 Sheringham, Holt, Blickling, A140 Aylsham, B1150 Coltishall, B1150 North Walsham Road, into NORWICH CITY CENTRE via Magdalen Road, Bull Close Road, St Crispins, Barn Road, Grapes Hill, Cleveland Road, Bethel Street, St Peters Street, Exchange Street, St Andrews Street, Bank Plain to Prince of Wales Road, Riverside Road, Gurney Road onto the C283 Salhouse Road, B1140 Salhouse, A1151 Wroxham, A1062 Horning, A149 Ludham, Potter Heigham, Rollesby, Ormesby, Caister-On-Sea into GREAT YARMOUTH via Jellicoe Road, North Drive, Marine Parade, Trafalgar Road, Yarmouth Way, South Quay, Southgates Road, Main Cross Road, South Beach Parade where the Tour will end on 16 September 2010 at 1630hrs.
- e) To facilitate the Tour finish from 0500hrs to 1930 hrs at C607 South Beach Parade, U60765 Dickens Avenue from C607 South Beach Parade for 50m westwards and from 1330hrs to 1630hrs at C608 Main Cross Road in the BOROUGH OF GREAT YARMOUTH. Restriction on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained during the Tour.
